

# O.L.M. Activity Day and Swimming

Friday, June 18, 2010

The students will be participating in activity day and eating lunch at school. From the school we will be walking to Canada Games Pool for our school swimming party from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m.

All children 6 years of age must be supervised in the large pool. The student can play in the smaller pool without supervision. Children 7 years or older may be required to remain in the smaller pool based on height or swimming ability. These decisions will be made by the Canada Games Pool's staff.

Parents are required to pick up their child(ren) at the Canada Games Pool at 2:30. Please wait outside the pool. Teachers will establish a "home base" for their students outside the pool doors. Teachers will have their class list and students will be marked off as he or she is being picked up at the "home base." The student and parent must check in with the teacher.

***Please note:***

- The teacher is not allowed to let a student leave without visually seeing the parent.
- If your child is being picked up by daycare please have this arranged ahead of time.
- If your child is being picked up by another parent, a written note of consent (naming the individual who is picking up the student) must be brought with the child ahead of time.
- If your child is walking, a written note of consent must be given to the teacher.
